- 1. Set up 24-channel Mackie mixer with Mackie speakers as main speakers
- 2. Set up the onboard light
- 3. Set up the following:
 - a. Vocal mic 1 at the board
 - b. Vocal mic 2 on stage
 - c. iPod
 - d. Talk back mic
 - e. Video feed direct to camera
 - f. Video feed from 6 individual channels to field mixer
 - g. Aux Sends 1-4 to stage for monitors
- 4. Set proper trim levels for all channels in use
- 5. Send all signals to main speakers at an appropriate level
- 6. Use talkback mic and send to main mix and/or aux sends
 - a. What is the biggest danger with the talkback mic?
- 7. Send vocal mic 1 to sub-group 1, channels 4-8 to sub-group 2, channels 9-12 to subgroup 3, and the iPod to sub-group 4. Put all into the main mix.
 - a. Explain concept of sub-groups and discuss practical uses.
- 8. Discuss the onboard 3-band EQ including the variable mid-range parameters and our subtractive approach to "dialing in" a tone.
 - a. What factors will typically affect tone?
 - b. Make the vocal mic 1 sound like each of the 5 mid-range frequency areas we outlined which will be presented to you in random order.
- 9. Explain concept of aux sends and discuss practical uses
 - a. Demonstrate individual and master level controls
 - b. Demonstrate solo for aux sends
- 10. Discuss how to adjust Mackie speakers for use at large outdoor venues
- 11. Power down
- 12. Zero mixer
- 13. Disconnect light from mixing board
- 14. Undo all connections
