## **SETTING UP AUX SYSTEM (WITH JBL SPEAKERS)**

## GEAR NEEDED:

Power amp rack Mixing board (any board is OK) JBL speakers (2, 3, or 4 depending on context) Speaker stands Cables box and whatever XLR you need Mic box Extension cord (if needed)

## SETUP:

- 1. position amp rack and mixing board at mixing station
- 2. set up speaker stands (use wide base for stability) and speakers in optimal positions to audience
- 3. plug in mixing board to amp rack power strip
- 4. plug in amp power cord to amp rack power strip
- 5. plug in amp rack power strip to wall
- 6. make connections from mixing board to amp
  - a. use 5' XLR cables to go from MAIN OUTS of board to INPUTS of amp. Be consistent with connections: LEFT/INPUT 1 and RIGHT/INPUT 2
- 7. make connections between amp and speakers
  - a. use Speakon-Speakon cables if possible. Banana-Speakon or Banana-1/4" are also OK
  - b. leave OUTPUT 1 on amp and run into LEFT JBL input
  - c. leave OUTPUT 2 on amp and run into RIGHT JBL input
  - d. daisy chain speakers via 1/4" connections if needed
- 8. make all input connections to mixing board (mics, etc.)
- 9. double check board and amp are ZEROED
- 10. power up gear
  - a. turn on amp rack power strip
  - b. mixing board FIRST
  - c. power amp LAST
- 11. set input signals (trim or gain) to peak at 0db on board meter. Solo button must be engaged
- 12. set main fader and individual channel faders to unity or 0db
- 13. unmute channel and disengage solo button (assign L-R if needed)
- 14. gradually turn up amp volume (while making signal) until desired level is acquired in hall

## STRIKE:

- 1. ZERO board and amp
- 2. power down
  - a. amp FIRST
  - b. board next
  - c. power strip last
- 3. undo all connections
- 4. return all items to appropriate cases
